



TRACK RULES

The driver is responsible for ALL of his/her crew, family or friends that come into the pits. If any of these rules are broken by any of these people the driver may be penalized. Penalties include but are not limited to, loss of points, payouts or suspension. **Any driver that wants to meet with officials, you can 20 minutes after the last feature race in the scoring room. Please notify the Race Director or Track Director first.**

1. To be in the "pit area", you must wear your wristband at all times. This includes children over the age of two years old.
2. Our pit area includes all the area past the office building (first white building), including the cement area on the track side of the two white buildings, including the deck.
3. No one is allowed on the track during racing except track personnel.
4. Scoring tower and flag stands are off limits.
5. No alcohol until racing is complete. No alcoholic beverages allowed in the Pit Area. Any driver caught consuming alcoholic beverages during races will be barred from racing.
6. No fighting on the premises. Obscene gestures and language will not be tolerated. If a driver is caught fighting on the track or premises, he or she will be disqualified for that night and barred from the track for a time determined by track officials.
7. No verbal assault, either public or written, of any Jackson Speedway staff member or physical assault.
8. We reserve the right to refuse admission to anyone for any reason
9. Pit vehicles are used for pushing cars to and from the pits, they are not to be ridden as toys. Anyone joy riding (speeding, wheelies, donuts, etc.) will have their pit vehicle parked for the night. Other penalties are possible.
10. No reckless driving on the property. **The speed limit is 10 mph.**
11. All children under the age of 12 years must be supervised.
12. The track is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property.
13. All pets must be on a leash.
14. Points are determined by the total of all points races minus one drop of lowest score, including DNW, DNS or Blanks.

16. Transponders need to be returned immediately at the end of racing: either at the scales or at Registration.

Jackson Speedway reserves the right to change, delete or add to rules throughout the racing season. The management reserves the right of interpretation of all rules and the right to inspect and reject any car and/or driver, crew member, etc., during the racing program.
